## AMENDMENT n°3 Notice of Race

#### Article 9.1.1 : In Paris

#### Add:

At the prize giving ceremony which will take place during the Nautic boat show in Paris, Saturday 6th, 2014 at 3:00 pm, otherwise, prizes will not be presented.

#### Article 9.1.2 : In Saint Malo

**Cancel** : At the prize giving ceremony in Saint-Malo which will take place during the first quarter of 2015, otherwise, prizes will not be presented.

#### Article 16 : TROPHIES ET PRIZES

#### \* Prizes for the race ranking

Only boats which have crossed the finishing line of the Route du Rhum – Destination Guadeloupe are eligible for trophies and prizes.

Prizes will be distributed as follows :

Multihulls Ultimes

$1^{st}$ :	50 000 €
$2^{nd}$ :	25 000 €
$3^{rd}$ :	12 500 €

#### Multihulls Multi50

1<sup>st</sup>: 12 000 €

2<sup>nd</sup>: 8 000 €

3<sup>rd</sup> : 6 000 €

Boats registered and which will cross the finishing line between the 4th and 11th place will receive  $3\ 250 \notin$  each. In case a boat would abandon,  $3\ 250 \notin$  will be paid in the class Multi50.
