Option 1:

- Deliver boat via ship or sail to Charleston
- Dry Storage and ability to refit in a secure, full-service boat yard

Option 2:

- Deliver boat to Antigua for Caribbean 600 in February
- After the Caribbean 600, deliver to Charleston.

Option 3:

- Informal race/rally from Itajai to Charleston
- We would organize, along with the Class 40, an informal rally from Brazil to Charleston to safely receive the boats in the U.S.
