

## **Selection Committee Minutes**

*Friday, January 19 2026, by videoconference.*

The Class40 Board of Directors received an application for the Selection Committee.

In accordance with the rules of the Selection System (article 5), the Board appointed a Selection Committee made up of Jacques Fournier, Miranda Merron, Bertrand Delesne, Gautier Nollet and Vanessa Boulaire.

As a preamble, we remind you that :

- that the allocation of miles to one member would necessarily be to the disadvantage of another, who would fall back in the ranking: each decision must therefore be explicable and justifiable
- Decisions must be taken in line with the objectives stated in the introduction to the selection system.

### **Request – Aina Bauza et Axelle Pillain**

“We took part in the Globe 40 prologue in double-handed sailing. In accordance with the Permanent Selection System for races subject to Class40 quotas, and more specifically point 2 relating to the Globe 40, it is stated that although this race does not appear on the Class calendar, its participants (provided that their membership fees are up to date) may log miles, up to a maximum limit of 5,000 miles, in accordance with the rules set out in Article 1.

Furthermore, as indicated in the Notice of Race, and in particular in Article 10 relating to the course, the Globe 40 prologue forms an integral part of the Globe 40 course. For these reasons, and based on the regulations as they are written, we would like to request that the 1,000 miles of the prologue be taken into account within the framework of the Class40 selection system.

We thank you in advance for the attention given to our request and, of course, remain at your disposal for any further information.”

### **Décision**

The boat concerned by the request is not officially ranked on the race website, either in the prologue standings or in the overall online rankings. It appears in the former only as a ‘guest’ (see below).

The boat is therefore not part of the race and cannot, as such, log miles. It should be noted that the organizer had already raised this question in spring 2025, and that the Board of Directors replied as follows:

‘The Board of Directors discussed yesterday the possibility of logging miles on the Globe40 prologue.

Unanimously, the Board members decided against it, for several reasons: an event that is part of

another and that could not accommodate all boats, an already fixed calendar, and competition with the 40 Malouine.’

It is also recalled that the Selection System has been published for more than 18 months, and that it would have been preferable for questions relating to an event to be raised prior to it.
